



VOLUNTEER DEPLOYMENT PROGRAM
BE PART OF THE PA-12 SPECIAL ELECTION 72-HR
OPERATION

Friday, May 14-Election Day, May 18

LOCATIONS:

All deployed volunteers will be assigned to a HQ location based on need and capacity. **Please contact Kali Dean** at kdean@rnchq.org to RSVP and you will receive your office assignment and lodging arrangements from her before your departure date.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

LODGING: In order to receive hotel accommodations, you must commit to two full days of deployment. This means arriving in time for the first shift at 9 AM, staying through the final shift at 9 PM and then arriving back at HQ at 9 AM the following day and staying through the shift ending at 9 PM. If you are coming alone, plan to be paired up with another deployed volunteer, as all rooms will house two people. If you are coming with a friend and want to be paired up with them, please indicate that in your email to Kali. Your hotel room will be booked for you in the same town you are assigned to; again, that information will be given to you from Kali. If you are able to provide your own lodging, please contact Kali to get more information about the office closest to where you are staying.

TRAVEL/PER DIEM: A bus will be provided from DC for a Fri. May 14th – Sun. May 16th trip, leaving DC at 9:00am from outside the Capitol South Metro Station and will depart Pennsylvania back to DC at 3:00 pm on Sunday afternoon. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide a per diem for this deployment opportunity.

- **We do need to recruit drivers for door to door operation so if you were planning on driving yourself into the district or if you are able to drive your own vehicle, we will provide gas cards.**

MEALS: All meals will be provided for all volunteers in each HQ.

WHAT YOU'LL BE DOING:

A standard day will comprise a firm schedule of a combination of door-to-door canvassing and phone bank shifts. We will fill phone shifts with deployed volunteers, as well as local volunteers. Those who prefer calling rather than doing door-to-door activities will be selected on a first-come basis until we reach phone capacity. All other deployed volunteers will be going door-to-door. Door-to-door volunteers will be broken into groups of four, including one driver (five people per group). All groups will be given a brief training and walk packets, which will include literature, a clip board, pens, walk books, driving directions and scripts.

WHO YOU'LL BE CONTACTING:

The 72-hour period will be our strongest push to get our identified supporters to the polls on Election Day.

WHAT WE NEED TO KNOW:

In order to most effectively plan and schedule the volunteer effort, it is important that we know who you are! **Please send your RSVP Kali Dean (kdean@rnchq.org) before Noon, Wed. May 12th.** Please be sure to include: your cell phone number and email, what day and time you will be arriving in PA and when you plan on leaving, how many people—if any—you will be bringing with you and whether or not you will have your own transportation.
