RE: BATTLEGROUND POLLING ON IA-02

The following memo is based on a survey fielded March 22-25, 2021. N=1,200 interviews were fielded across 16 congressional districts. All interviews were conducted at a live, professional call center, and 40% of interviews were completed via cell phone.

- ***Voters in battleground districts are overwhelmingly opposed to Congressional Democrats' attempt to overturn the IA-02 certified election results.***
 - Sixty-eight percent (68%) of voters oppose Nancy Pelosi and House Democrats' attempt to overthrow the election results in IA-02, and a full 54% strongly oppose.
 - The idea of overturning the IA-02 election results is vastly unpopular across different blocks of voters, including 62% of suburban voters, 66% of college graduates, 69% of independents, and 62% of seniors.
 - Even a plurality (44%) of Democrats oppose the effort to overturn the IA-02 election results.
 - By a nearly 2-1 margin (58-31%) voters agree that House Democrats are being hypocritical after those same Democrats dismissed President Trump's requests for investigations into the Presidential election and accepted Joe Bidens victory.
 - Fifty-three percent (53%) of suburban voters, 62% of non-college voters, 57% of independents, and 53% of seniors all agree with the statement that Democrats are acting hypocritically.

The bottom line is that House Democrats' attempt to steal a battleground congressional seat is politically toxic and will further hinder their already-dim 2022 election chances.
