



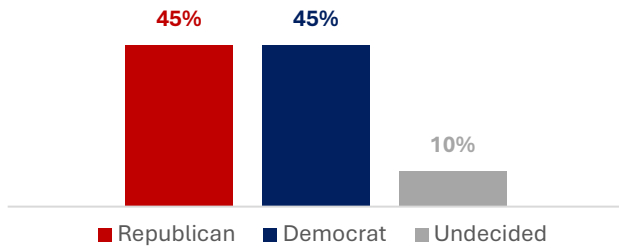

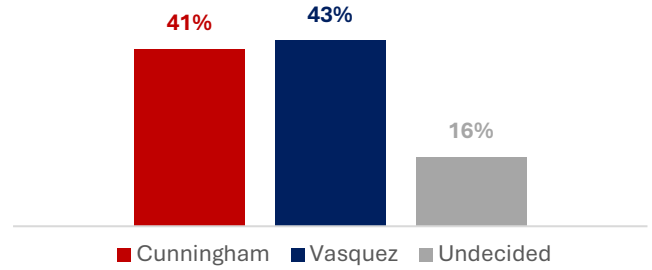

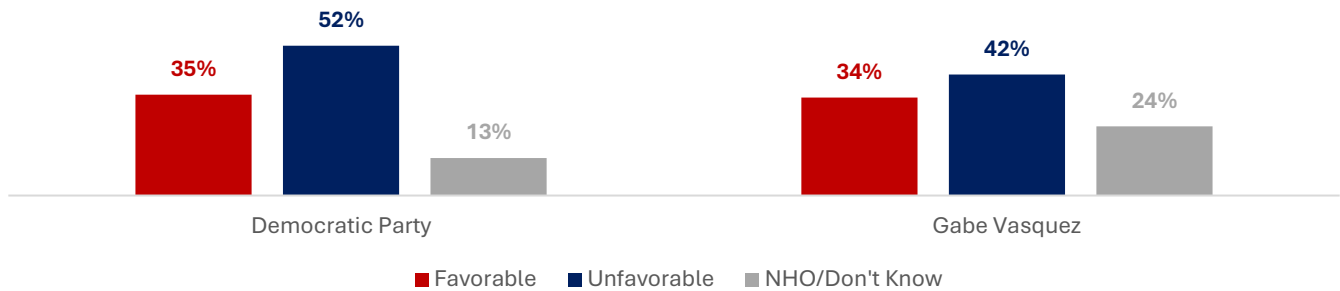
**NM-02 Generic Ballot**

### KEY FINDINGS

- Gabe Vasquez is in a tossup race against an unknown challenger.** The generic ballot is tied at 45% - 45%. Gabe Vasquez leads Greg Cunningham by only 2% (43% - 41%), well within the margin of error. Greg Cunningham starts off with support from almost 40% of Hispanics and is winning with voters with a high propensity to turn out.
- Greg Cunningham has a large persuasion runway.** Thirty-seven percent (37%) of voters have not yet heard of Cunningham, and another 31% are unsure. He is statically tied with a two-term incumbent who is already -8% on his image.
- Gabe Vasquez carries structural vulnerability.** Vasquez sits at 34% favorable - 42% unfavorable, an -8% net image. He is -16% with Independents and -6% with Hispanics. Vasquez is not in negative territory by accident: Governor Lujan Grisham has a -14% net approval rating, and the Democratic brand sits at -18%. 51% of voters in NM-02 support a candidate that will vote to pass Donald Trump's agenda in Congress rather than Joe Biden's.

**METHODOLOGY:** co/efficient conducted a survey of the 2026 General Election in New Mexico's 2nd Congressional District, the survey fielded April 26-28, 2026. The survey comprised 879 likely general election voters and was conducted using mobile text responses and landline interviews. Results were balanced to reflect the age, gender, education level, race, DMA, community type, and registered party of the true voting population, with a margin of error of +/- 3.29%.
