



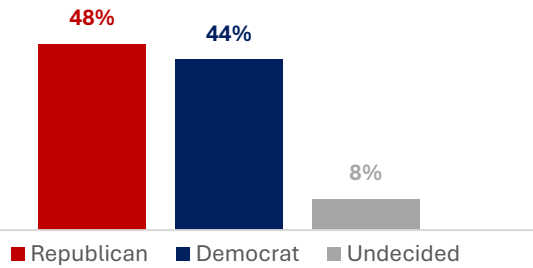

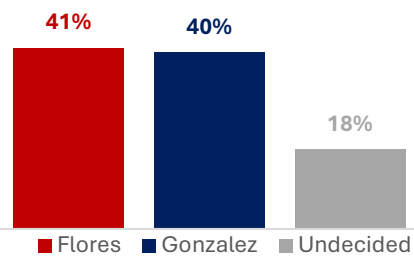

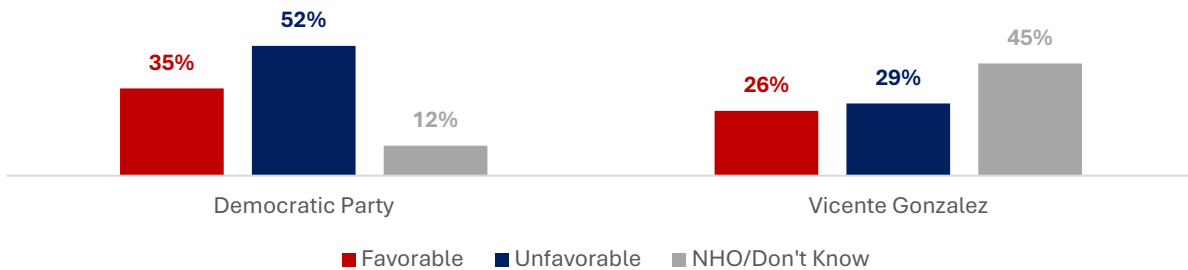
### TX-34 Generic Ballot

## KEY FINDINGS

- **Eric Flores already has the edge over Vicente Gonzalez in the race for TX-34.** Flores leads nine-year incumbent, Gonzalez, 41% to 40% on the named ballot. The Generic Republican leads by 4% (48% -44%) and is receiving support from almost 40% of Hispanics.
- **Almost half of voters (45%) do not know who Vicente Gonzalez is.** Gonzalez is still defining himself. Gonzalez is at 26% favorable – 29% unfavorable. He is -4% with seniors and -13% with Independents.
- **Vicente Gonzalez faces an uphill climb in the current political environment.** The Generic Ballot is R+4% and 51% of voters prefer the Trump agenda over that of the Biden agenda. Gonzalez will be tied to the Democratic Party which is -17% on its image.

**METHODOLOGY:** co/efficient conducted a survey of the 2026 General Election in Texas' 34th Congressional District, it fielded April 25-29, 2026. The survey comprised 777 likely general election voters and was conducted using mobile text responses and landline interviews. Results were balanced to reflect the age, gender, education level, race, DMA, and community type of the true voting population, with a margin of error of +/- 3.50%.
