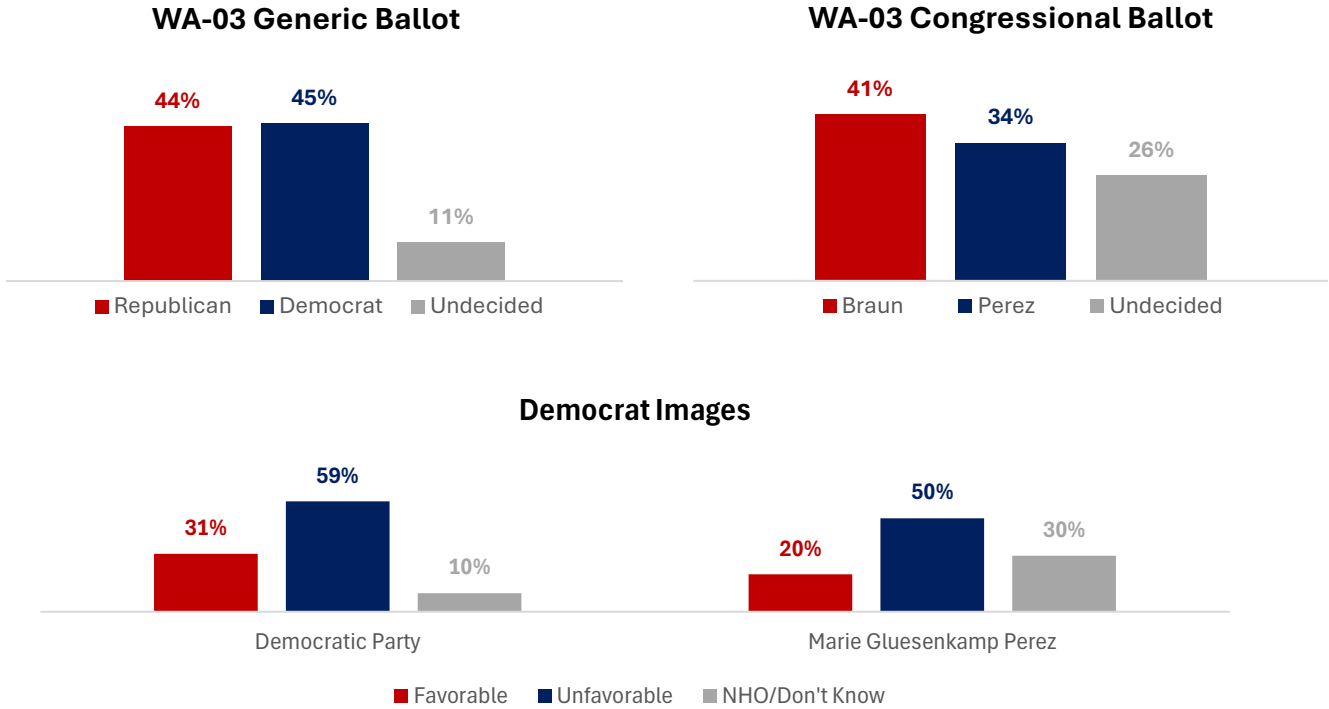

### THE STATE OF THE DISTRICT



### KEY FINDINGS

- Marie Gluesenkamp Perez is dangerously damaged for a Democratic incumbent.**
  - Gluesenkamp Perez is viewed unfavorably by 50% of voters, a -30% net image.
  - She is viewed unfavorably by 49% of Independents, 46% of young voters, and *a third of Democrats* (33%).
  - She is only getting 69% of Democrats on the Congressional ballot, she has a serious base problem.
- John Braun leads the head-to-head by 7% with room to grow.** Braun leads Marie Gluesenkamp Perez 41% to 34%. Braun is relatively unknown at 24% favorable – 20% unfavorable with 56% combined unsure or never heard, creating a clear path to further consolidate and expand his advantage as the race develops.
- Governor Ferguson compounds the Democratic drag down ballot.** Only 22% of voters in WA-03 approve of the job Bob Ferguson is doing as governor. The Democratic brand in the district sits at -28%. There are several headwinds that Marie Gluesenkamp Perez is facing to win against John Braun.

**METHODOLOGY:** co/efficient conducted a survey of the 2026 General Election in Washington’s 3rd Congressional District, it fielded April 25-29, 2026. The survey comprised 982 likely general election voters and was conducted using mobile text responses and landline interviews. Results were balanced to reflect the age, gender, education level, race, county, and community type of the true voting population, with a margin of error of +/- 3.12%.
